Below find my OBJECTIONS to the above: -

- 1) 41 dwellings will further decrease the rural character of FORTON village and increase the urbanization
- 2) Loss of prime agricultural land
- 3) Increase in rainwater run-off onto adjacent roads & fields
- 4) Loss of wild-life habitats
- 5) Increase pressure on foul water drainage (i.e. sewers)
- 6) Increase in light pollution
- 7) Access - School Lane is already suffering excessive traffic. The road is for much of its length only one vehicle width with a visibility hazard just west of the cricket field. The road surface & verges cannot take any more pressure.
- 8) Proximity of the Village School means increased traffic a hazard to children
- 9) With no present village shops, lack of public transport into the village and no other facilities this makes further housing unsuitable for an ageing village population
