



My main objection to this proposal is the problem of increased traffic on a road that cannot be improved to accommodate it. Forton west of the A6 was very thinly populated until the 1950s and the main route to and from the A6 has remained virtually the same as it was 60 years ago despite all the growth in population. The further developments already approved will put more pressure on the School Lane/A6 junction and there are already plans to make changes there. But this proposal to build many homes further west will create pressure along part of School Lane where existing buildings make improvements impossible. This is the section between Willow Close and the Winder Lane junction, along which many of the residents need roadside parking. The current flow of traffic creates problems here, especially at school times, and a very large development like this would create huge problems in the future.
