As discussed with the tree office last year, I would like to plan for the attached maintenance work for our Lime trees. It was suggested and advised the the uplift would be the best option for these trees rather than reducing the crowns. Sutton Trees who will carry out the work also agreed with the suggestion to uplift rather than reducing the crown.

We have two areas of Limes Tress - Area 1 (Trees marked 1-7) Crown lift of approx 5 metres Area 2 (trees marked 8 -12) Crown Lift of approx 6 metres - with additional removal on tree 11 of marked branch which is growing sidewise of approx 4 m to the next vertical branch.

Both sets of tree to cut away dead wood
