THE PROPOSAL

THE SINGLE STOREY REAR EXTENSION WILL BE IN A FORM OF A GLASS ROOF CONSERVATORY.

MATERIALS

THE MATERIALS THAT THE CONSERVATORY WILL BE CONSTRUCTED FROM ARE:

BRICK FACED PLINTH WALLS TO MATCH EXISTING.

ROSEWOOD UPVC CASEMENT WINDOWS AND DOUBLE DOOR.

ROSEWOOD ROOF STRUCTURE WITH AMBI ULTRA GREY GLASS.

USE

THE CONSERVATORY WILL BE USED AS MUCH NEEDED ADDITIONAL LIVING AND LEISURE SPACE FOR THE APPLICANT.

AMOUNT

THE INTERNAL FLOOR AREA OF THE PROPOSED CONSERVATORY IS 8.62 SQ/M.

LOCATION

IT IS PROPOSED THAT THE CONSERVATORY IS TO BE CONSTRUCTED ON THE SOUTH – WEST FACING REAR FLEVATION.

THE WHOLE SITE IS DISCREET AND LOCATED ON PRIVATE LAND OWNED BY THE APPLICANT.

LANDSCAPING

ACCESS
