

EXTERNAL: Front of the property



DESCRIPTION

Externally, both at the front and to the rear, the property consisted of dated single-glazed wooden windows which was a main factor in causing the energy performance of the house to be rated at 'F'.







DESCRIPTION

New whole house double-glazed UPVC windows & doors were installed, significantly increasing the energy performance from 'F' to 'C'. A Ring Doorbell increases the security of the property with the ability to watch the house from your smart device 24/7.

DESCRIPTION

Like every room in the house, the co-living space underwent all new decorative paintwork, flooring, pipe work, designer radiators and an electrical rewire. The smart HIVE central heating system controls can also be seen to the left of the designer radiator.

ROOM: Co-living Space & Work Pod






DESCRIPTION

The existing co-living space was outdated and required major works to modernise the room including a central heating system with new radiators, plastered walls, all new paintwork, flooring and a comfortable place to work from home given the rise in the freelance occupation over recent years.



DETAILS MAKE THE DESIGN

ROOM: Co-living Space & Work Pod



DESCRIPTION

The concept of a Libra Spaces design is to inspire a social community & togetherness within the house. A place where work can be discussed with others to enhance work/life balance & encourage a healthy mindset & improve mental health. This was achieved by introducing a work pod to the co-living space.

DESCRIPTION

A new kitchen and new appliances were required to modernise the property.

DESCRIPTION

New kitchen units, doors, appliances and worktops were installed. In addition, the walls were plastered and decorative paintwork added to suit the industrial-styled theme of the house.

ROOM: Kitchen & Tea/Coffee Area



DESCRIPTION

A new working kitchen sink and washing facility was required in addition to a new decor, flooring, plaster, window and external back door.

A new kitchen sink, faucet & fridge/freezer were installed including a dedicated tea & coffee station. All the walls were plastered, newly painted, new windows & doors and flooring.

DESCRIPTION

A small passageway between the kitchen and bathroom was in need of modernisation. This space was utilised to add a utility area.

DESCRIPTION

A utility area was added which consists of a washing machine, dryer and built-in storage space. The external back door was also replaced from wooden single-glazed to UPVC double-glazed.

ROOM: Bathroom Pan & Shower Area



DESCRIPTION

Just like the kitchen, the exisiting bathroom was in need of a major refurbishment. The old boiler had also malfunctioned.

A new bathroom suite was installed with all new pipe work including a pan, shower tray, thermostatic shower and wall & floor tiles. A new combination boiler was also installed.


ROOM: Bathroom: Basin Area
