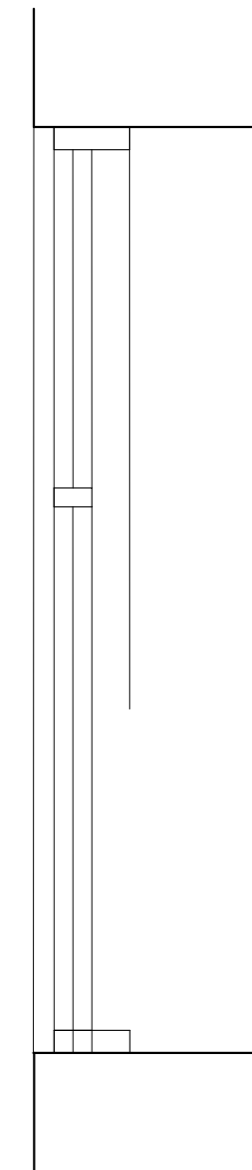
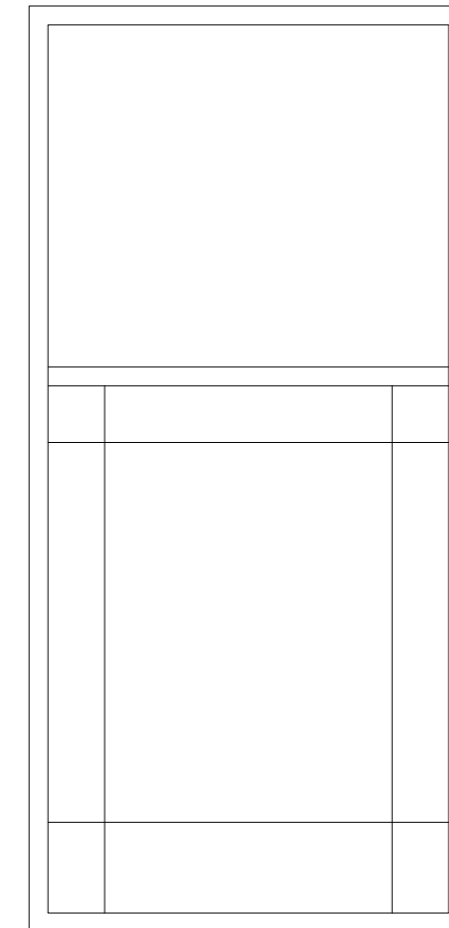
Plan and section through proposed sash and case window

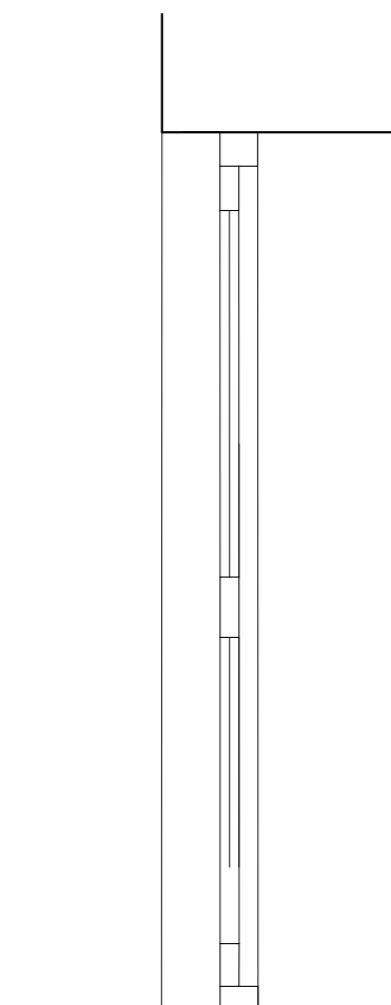
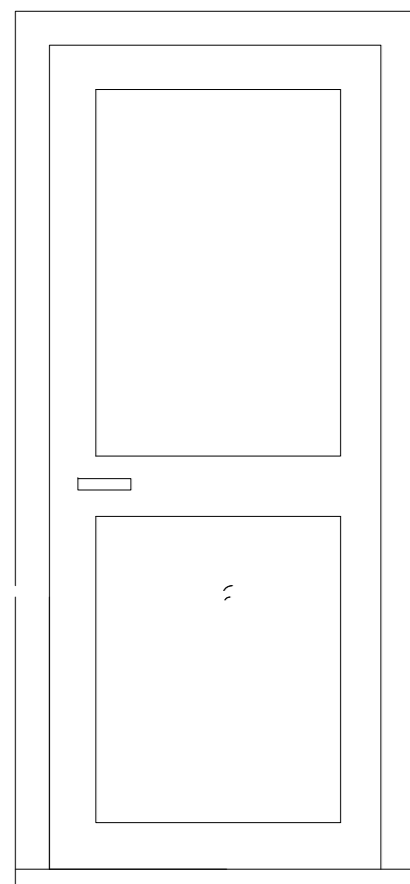
Plan and section through proposed sash and case window

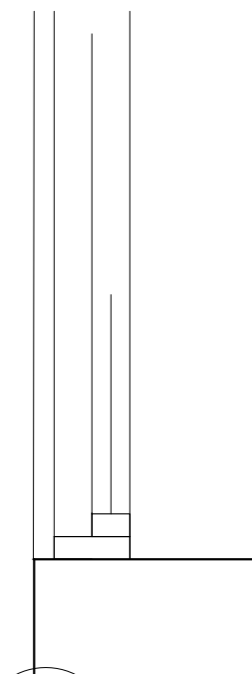
