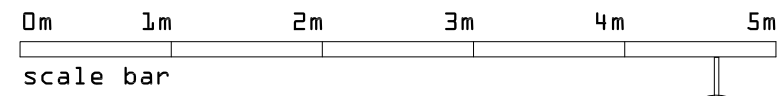


The Merryburn Hotel, Station Road, Birnam

all first floor windows to hotel replaced with new double glazed timber fully functioning sash and case units to match existing in every respect

no changes to main hotel windows at ground floor

entire roof re-roofed with reclaimed slates to match existing and all flashings and lead details etc replicated to match existing where replaced

all mews windows and doors (to rear here) replaced with new double glazed timber fully functioning sash and case units to match existing in every respect

existing gate retained to access hotel garden

stone wall retained

new gate and opening in wall formed for access to garden for mews at 19 Birnam Terrace
