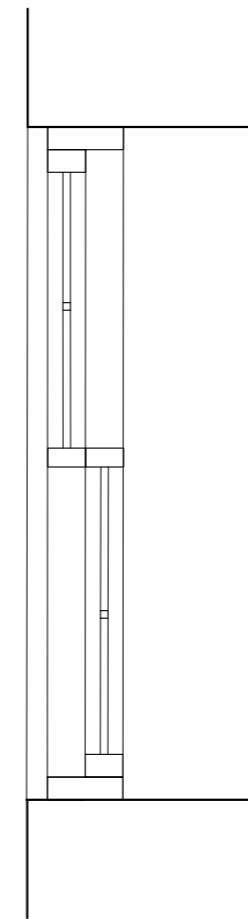
Plan and section through existing sash and case window



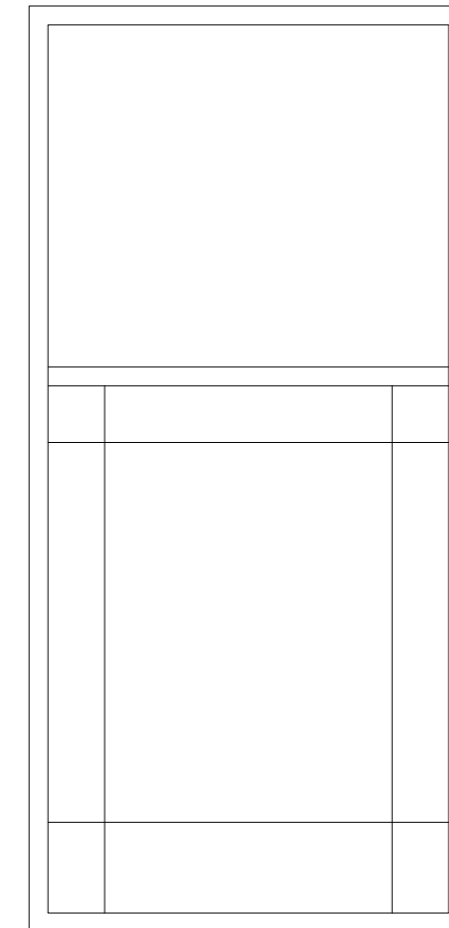

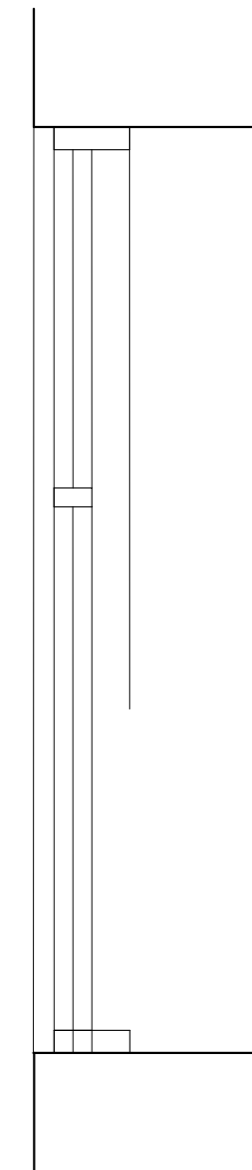
Plan and section through existing sash and case window



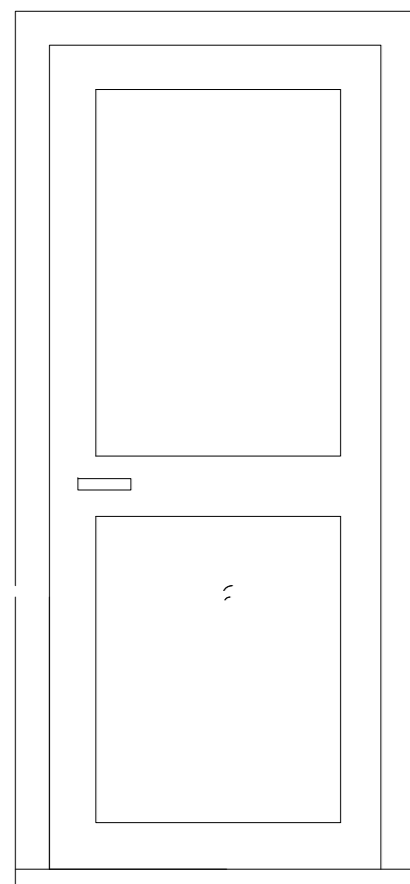

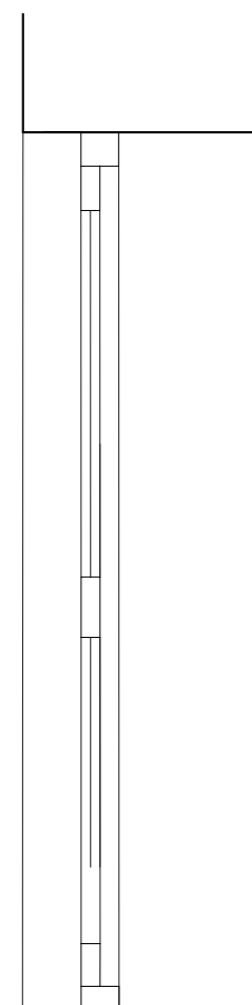
Plan and section through existing sash and case window



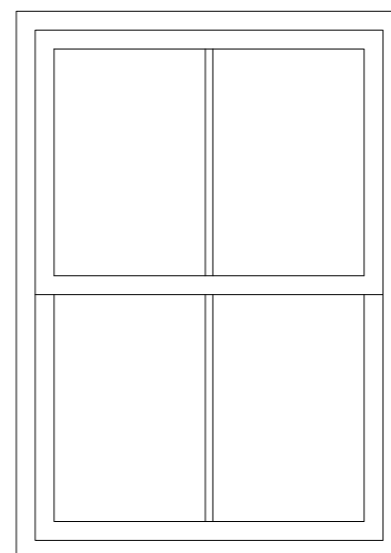

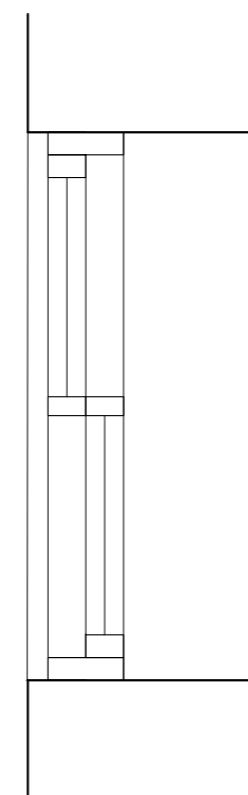

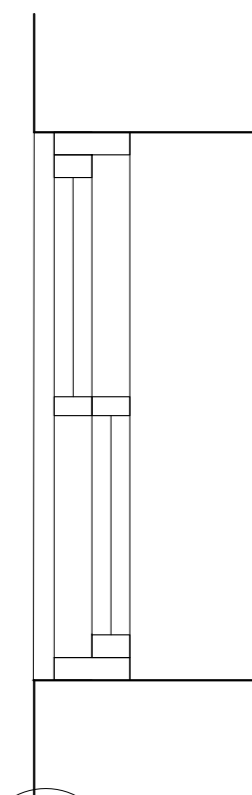
Plan and section through existing sash and case window
