Summary of Comments:	
<p>The tree is of low public amenity as located to the rear of building and centrally within the site. The tree has had recent stem failure which has resulted in a exposed crown remaining crown. The structural integrity of the tree has been further reduced with the presence of a wood decaying fungi.</p> <p>We recommend consent to these works with a replacement planting condition recommended inline with the requirements of the Tree Protection Order.</p>	
Main Comment:	
<p>The tree is of low public amenity as located to the rear of building and centrally within the site. The tree has had recent stem failure which has resulted in a exposed crown remaining crown. The structural integrity of the tree has been further reduced with the presence of a wood decaying fungi.</p> <p>We recommend consent to these works with a replacement planting condition recommended in line with the requirements of the Tree Protection Order.</p> <p>As such we recommend the application for approval with a replacement planting condition in line with the Tree Preservation Order legislation.</p> <p>Replacement tree</p> <p>Within the first planting season following the completion of the tree removal, replacement tree/s shall be provided in a similar position and species.</p> <p>All planting shall be completed in accordance with standard arboricultural practices In the event that any such trees die or become seriously damaged or diseased within a period of five years following planting they shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of a similar size and species.</p> <p>Reason: In the interests of the amenity and the landscape character of the area.</p>
