With respect to the specific items your raise:

- 1. I enclose a completed copy of what I understand to be the "simplified Matrix" (though that title does not seem to appear anywhere) concerning flood risk information.
- 2/3 As the foundations for the building being replaced will be used unchanged for the new building there will be no change in the basic floor levels. The new building will, however, have an internal insulated floating floor overlaying the concrete base. The horizontal concrete base is on a slope from NW to SE and there will be no change in the ground levels. These are shown on the elevations (D to G).
- 4. I am submitting a revised set of plans as follows:
