The tree is a large specimen that has previously been reduced due to the proximity to the public highway. It is situated in the southwestern corner of the grounds and in close proximity to two boundary walls and a garage. The wall adjacent to the public highway is damaged and in danger of falling onto the road. A builder has assessed the wall and determined that the tree is likely to be the cause. Given the damaged wall and the close proximity to the two walls and garage, the tree is considered by officers to have outgrown its very limited situation and that a TPO would not be appropriate.
