<u>AIM</u>

To create more space for users of the bar area and to offer a view into the Sports / TV Area for residents and staff. To remove the 'pinch point' and make the facilities more available.

ACCESSIBILITY

The is a level different between the TV area and bar. A discreet handrail will be fixed to enable easy of access for ambulant users.

There will be waiter service so there will not be much traffic between rooms.

CHARACTER

The timber panelling will be retained in the Bar and its character and detailing continued to maintain the ambience that exists for bar users.

The door will be refurbished, fireplace retained, and soft furnishings introduced to create a bar available to all hotel guests and members of the public.

MOVEMENT

The bar has been designed to soften the formality of the hotel and lessen the atmosphere to create a

relaxed ambience whilst accepting level differences between rooms. Unfortunately, there is no room

to provide ramps for disabled users. The existing lift provides access to the TV area not the bar.

SUMMARY

The proposed alterations will remove the isolation of rooms and open out the bar to its ancillary

rooms – TV Area. This proposal along with the general redecoration and refurbishment will uplift

this facility within the Hotel and provide a focal point to be enjoyed by both hotel guests and

members of the public.
