TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS

A (outline/full) planning application, application for listed building consent/conservation area consent has been made to Portsmouth City Council as follows:

LOCATION: 27 Cleveland Road Southsea PO5 1SF

PROPOSAL: Change of use from purposes falling within a (Class C4) HMO to HMO for more than 6 persons (Sui Generis) including bicycle stand. (20/01211/FUL)

If you are unable to access the plans online, please contact the case officer below who can arrange for the appropriate plans to be sent to you. Due to the current restrictions our ability to conduct site visits is limited. Should you wish to draw the Case Officer's attention to any particular view, or feature, or part of the local character, beyond what you may submit in writing, please send in photos, or perhaps a 'virtual' site visit/video. This will enable the Case Officer to better assess the proposals and any comments you may have.*

Comments must be made by **3 February 2021** in writing to the Civic Offices, or e-mailed to planningreps@portsmouthcc.gov.uk. The Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 allows any representation to be seen by other members of the public including the applicant. *Because of the on-going restrictions to daily life and concerns about health due to the COVID 19 virus, we are giving a longer period of time than usual for any public comments (42 days instead of the statutory minimum of 21).*

Only a small number of applications are determined by the Planning Committee. If this application is to be determined by the Committee, you will not be notified unless you have commented and requested to speak at the Committee.
