

e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

Oak (T1) - To reduce crown by 2 metres. To reduce risk of further damage to the tree as tree has lost a limb in the past. Oak (T2) - to dead wood, remove lowest limb over road and crown reduce laterals over road by 3-4 metres. Tree has heavy low limbs over road which could present a risk. Ash (T3)- to repollard to previous pruning points.
