Comment Reasons:

Comment: Hook Green Lane is a very narrow lane, in some places only single lane with passing places. It is unsuitable for wide vehicles - it says so on the sign at the junction with Birchwood Road. There are no footpaths but it is used by walkers, horse riders, dog walkers, children walking to and from school, disabled people on scooters, people pushing buggies. It is already very dangerous to walk along and more heavy traffic will make it more so. Broad Lane also has no footpath and is narrow despite its name. Common Lane has 3 schools along it with all the traffic that entails. The village has more than enough traffic without extra cars and lorries. In my view the proposed site is totally unsuitable because of extra traffic entailed. Also the entrance by Wilmington Community Church would be unsafe.
