Comment: I am concerned about the size of the lorries that will be using hook green lane and surrounding areas. Hook green lane is a quiet country lane which is already over used. I do not feel it is appropriate for lorries of that size to be using our small quiet village lane. How often will these lorries be coming in and out of their compound? How much noise will they make whilst they are working in their compound? Again I'm commenting about this as our village is lovely and quiet and we would like to keep it this way.

My other concern is the shared entrance the new compound will have with the church car park. This car park is used by parents of children who attend Wilmington primary. They park in this car park and walk to and from the school. Lorries and children do not mix. Is this an accident waiting to happen if lorries are to share a carpark with primary school children who are trying to get to and from school. Many of the parents also have preschool children. This thought really worries me...
