Front door at centre, early C19 with flush and recess panels, panelled reveals and mou1ded architrave. Open pediment carried on moulded brackets.

Background.

This application seeks the following

The removal of a modern lean-to building currently used as a store and replaced with a Garden Room.

Proposals.

To demolish the existing lean to structure which is currently tyrollean rendered under a small plain tile roof and replace this will a flint faced walling under a natural slate roof to form a Garden Room.

There is no internal link proposed as the new building will be access from the garden only as per the existing structure so therefore there will be no alteration to the existing plan form.

The building retains a single storey scale and therefore retains a subservient relationship with the existing and main building.

The Garden Room will then provide a sheltered building so the current occupiers can use and enjoy the secluded and private gardens.

Access and Landscaping

The access arrangements and access to the site and buildings remain unchanged as do the current garden layout.
