Row of 6 Pine trees (not all require work).

Pine (2) - numerous small branches approximately 2.5 meters in length. Lateral reduction by 1 meter of these branches to stop pine needles blocking drainage on rear extension.

Pine (4) - lateral reduction by 1.5 meters of all sideways growth overhanging the property. Again this growth is now causing problems regarding drainage pipes blocking and is also beginning to block significant light down the side of the house.

Pine (6) - lateral reduction of crown that over hangs front garden by 1.5 meters. Client wishes more light to reach the grass as currently the tree is encouraging moss growth.

Crown clean 10% to also attempt to allow more light through without causing any limbs added exposure therefore increasing load bearing during storms.
