Reduce crown height and spread by 2.5 metres, leaving crown height of 18 metres and crown spread of 4 metres. focussing particularly on the limbs overhanging the property to the north west of the tree.

Two Laurel shrubs below the tree to be cut back by 2/3 meters in width to open up the ground area, a stretch of 10 meters long.
