FULL PLANNING PERMISSION

The LOUTH RURAL DISTRICT COUNCIL

acting on behalf of the County Council of Lincoln, Parts of Lindsey hereby give notice to
Mr. L. D. Morris, Longaorea, Nettleton, LINCOLN, acting on behalf of
Mr. H. Key, Prosperity Farm, AUTEORPE, Louth, Lincs.

that the application received on 14th November, 1972 for permission to

Erect a dwelling and garage and construct 1 x 12'0" vehicular access at South
Reston, O.S. 56.16, Field No. 133.

has been considered and that permission for this development in accordance with the plans and written
particulars submitted has been granted subject to the following conditions:-

- (1) The development to which this permission relates MUST be begun not later than the expiration
of FIVE YEARS from the date of this permission.
2. The occupation of the dwelling shall be limited to a person solely or mainly
employed, or last employed, in the locality in agriculture as defined in Section
290 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, or in forestry or a dependent of
such a person residing with him (but including a widow or widower of such a
person).

The reasons for the above conditions are:-

- (1) To comply with the provisions of Section 41 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971.
2. The site is in a rural area and permission has been granted only on account of agricultural need.

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
