As regards the width, pruning would not require a full metre all round.

The updated descriptions you have given for the Lilac and Overhanging Silver Birch are now fine, however for the Cherry tree, we need to have the reductions in terms of the final measurements, rather than just saying how much you will remove ☐ basically the guidelines state we need to know what would be left. You can say ☐reduce by one metre☐ as you have done, but we also need to know the ☐to☐ as well as the ☐by☐ if you see what I mean.

As an example, you could say reduce by one metre all round to leave height of (x) metres and width of (y) metres.

During these difficult times we ask you all to consider sending information to us via other means; however if your only option is to submit information to us via the post this will be picked up, but may take slightly longer than normal.

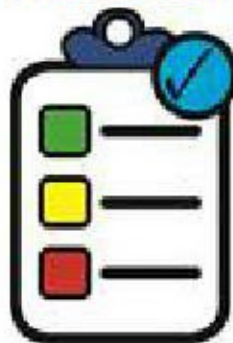
