Root decay. As recommended in the tree report, replace with another tree, the stem being 10-12cm diameter. Our preference would be Small Leaved Lime Greenspire or

Norway Maple Royal Red. The tree we believe is owned by the original builders of the houses in the 1970s. They are untraceable. The land is maintained by the residents of 6 and 7

Florence Close.
