Capacity 10,870 ltrs / 2391 Gallons

The tanks is emptied every 5yrs and has been done by Wansford Environmental services ltd. Attached are some photos of the invoice [sorry for the poor quality] on 25/06/2018 they removed 1000 gallons, it has since been done again by the new owners [Mr & Mrs Green] on the 22/01/20 in which they removed 600 Gallons.

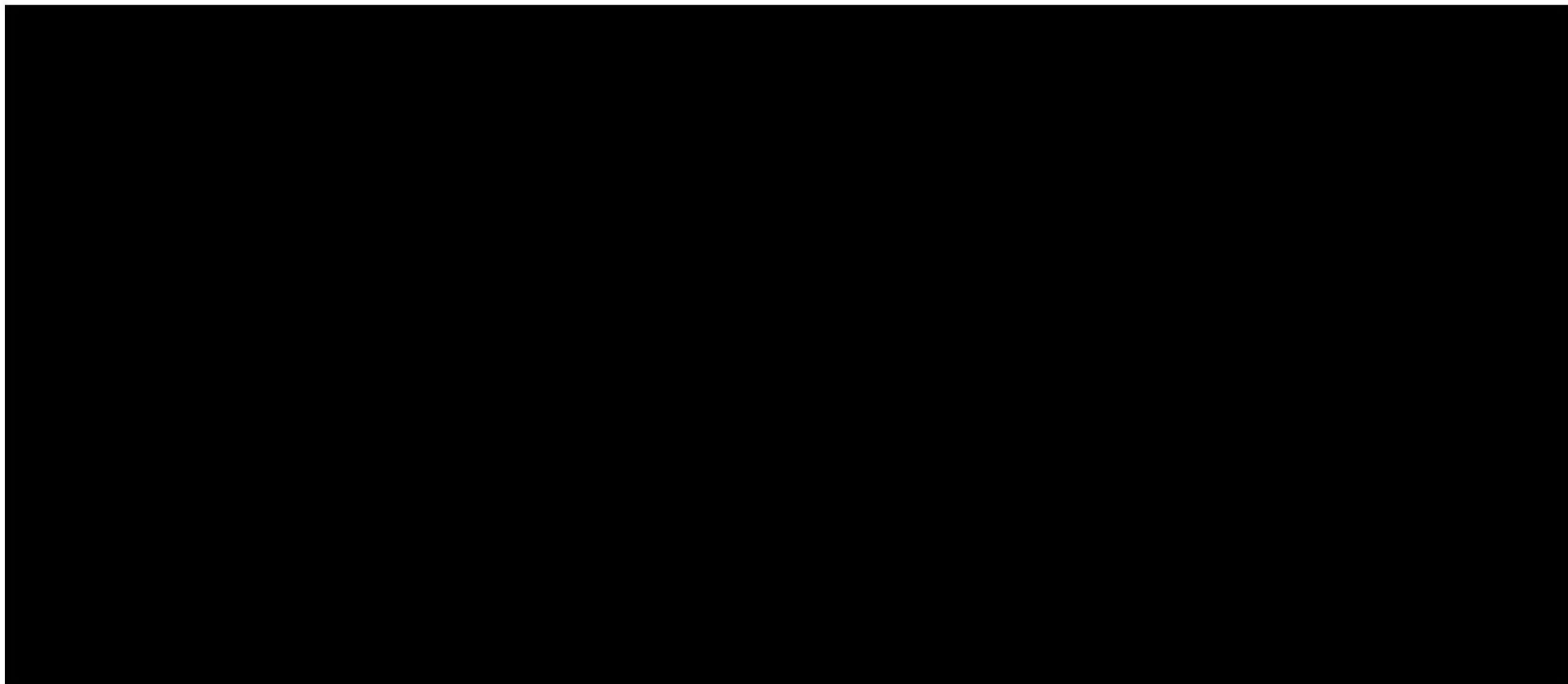
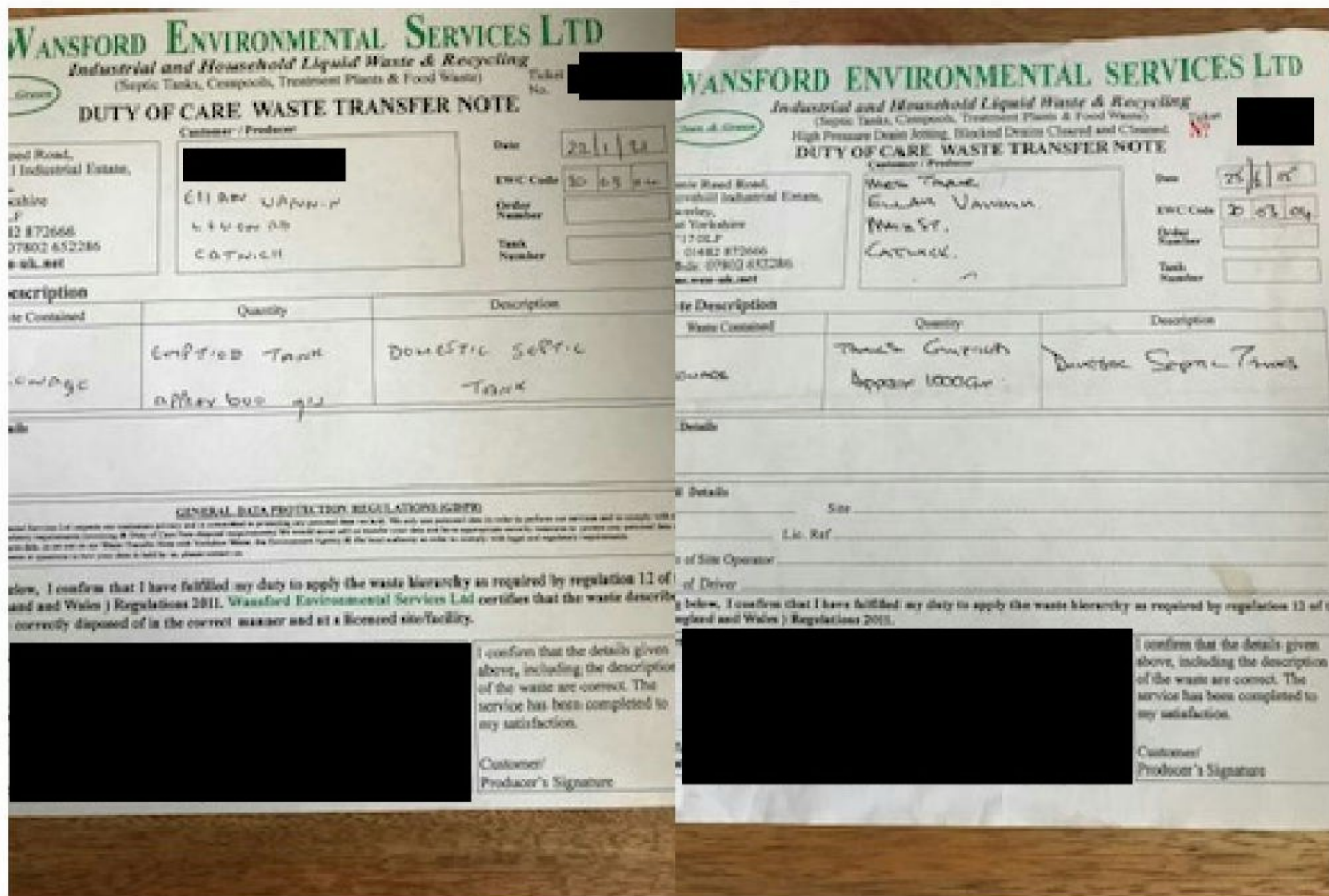
