Reference: Land at Goverseth, Foxhole, Northern Boundary Hedge

Dear Jane,

Further to your email concerning the site limitations (clay pipes running beneath the area) which prevent the creation of a Cornish Hedge bank along the northern boundary of the site I can offer the following input:

- From an ecological perspective there are no legal constraints to this as no protected species were found on site.
- The native species hedgerow will bring an ecological benefit to the site.
- The proposed hedgerow will maintain a commuting route for bats to travel around the site.
- The hedgerow will provide a shelter and foraging resource for a variety of invertebrates, mammals, birds and potentially reptiles (if the latter colonise the site in the future).
