







2.1. Interior view of sitting room facing south - note C20 joinery to alcoves and original door to left.




2.2. View of exterior wall to sitting room facing north - original door opening can be seen on left (infilled with stone)1a. Interior view of sitting


2.5. Wall between kitchen and store room.
