The tree is of no aesthetic value to the area and cannot be seen from roadside. A weight reduction would certainly help with the stability of the tree itself.							
Cherry (T2) - Remove to ground level. It has an extremely large cavity in the stem and if it falls it could cause damage to homeowners. Tree cant be seen from the road. This tree is in the garden of Manor Farm a little further down the road, and is shown on the second sketch plan attached.
