T1 Large, mature Yew within rear lawn. The tree has been pruned twice over the past 30 years with varying results. Our Aim is to reduce the crown significantly, but to create an even and well balanced "Cocktail glass" shape- Reduce height by approx 6m, Gently doming top- Reduce sides where required to balance and even shape.- Prune lower branches to complete a "Cocktail Glass" shape to the tree.

T2 Large Yew within communal land opposite front of property. Our aim is to reduce the height of the tree to allow light through to property but maintain appearance for neighbours amenity- Reduce height by approx 6m- Reduce lateral branches proportionately to blend into top to maintain a natural tree shape and balance but retain lower screening for neighbours- Lateral branches on southern sides to be retained where possible to maintain appearance for neighbours- Reduce overhang on driveway bay approx 2.m to improve access
