e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

TPO1289 (T3) Lime

Prune specified limb back to 1m from source. (See attached annotated Photo)

This limb has previously been reduced and left as over extended pollarded limb. Due to the nature of Lime and the weak regrowth from such a poor reduction this is not a suitable limb to retain in its current form. Due to best practice the limb should have initially been pruned back close to source as to not introduce a large wound to the main stem. As this has not been the case the regrowth has now lapsed best practice maintenance which states regrowth from pollarding requires yearly maintenance to ensure regrowth is strong and safe. As this is a protected tree and to mitigate future issues with the need to constantly re-pollard the limb it is advisable to prune the limb back to 1m from source as to not introduce a wound to the main stem. This will alleviate the need to constantly maintain regrowth as the trees resources will be diverted to the main canopy as the final limb position will not draw as much energy, as it will in its current form and constant stress from the need to prune/maintain its regrowth.
