Further Information to support this Tree Works Application.

Hopefully this explanation will assist with your decision and you will accept this letter as a report into the condition of the trees. For this particular application, I don't think that a professional assessment is required, as their poor condition is obvious.

We have recently moved to 11 Kennet Village, and one of the features that attracted us, was the garden. It is now very overgrown, but at one time it apparently won many awards and was even featured on "The Beechgrove Garden". We'd like to try to restore the garden and at the same time retain some of the original features. This application may be the first of several, depending on what we find.

As mentioned in the application main details, these Leylandii trees have been allowed to grow too high and some of the boughs are struggling to stay upright. About 25% of the boughs on the LH tree (looking north) are already sagging and are unrecoverable.

I'm hoping, that by reducing the height, it will be enough to save these trees as they make a nice feature and help to divide the garden into different areas. If in, two to three years from now, it is obvious that they couldn't be saved, then I'd like to remove them and replace them with something similar in the same location. Please let me know if this would be in order or require a further application at that time.
