Proposed building of Garden Studio, 9A Vinson Road, Liss, GU337NE

Tree Assessment

There is a large ash tree at the rear of the garden in the far lefthand corner as indicated on the block plan. At its nearest point it is at a distance of 6.5m from any excavation work on the development.

The foundations of the studio will be to a depth of 25cm total including gravel base, insulation and concrete floor. It will be a floating slab with no piles.

I have contacted a local arboricultural consultancy firm and they have advised me that a full Impact Assessment should not be necessary as long as no proposed works or building activity take place within a distance of 12 times the diameter of the tree.

The circumference of the tree at a height of 150cm is 151cm.

The diameter of the tree is therefore calculated at 48cm

The root protection zone is therefore a radius of 5.77m around the tree. (48cm x 12)

Upon advice I have therefore submitted a plan of the site that shows the tree protection zone at a radius of 5.77m and showing how work will be carried out without affecting this zone (see document 9a).

Please note.

- 1. A fencing cordon of high visibility mesh fencing will be placed around the root protection area.
- 2. The existing rear garden gate will be moved to a different position to allow access for building materials. See 9a.
- 3. There is plenty of space in the rest of the garden for construction work and storage of materials. See 9a.
