Please describe details of the proposed development or works including details of proposals to alter, extend or demolish the listed building(s): The application is related to an outbuilding located to the NE of Carwen Farmhouse. Currently the only means of entry to the outbuilding is via a neighbouring property (Middle Carwen). From inspection inside there was previously a doorway that would enable access directly from Carwen Farmhouse, however this doorway has been previously blocked-up with concrete bricks. The outbuilding is of traditional stone & rubble construction, we believe probably constructed mid-nineteeth century. The outbuilding is connected to the main house, Carwen Farmhouse by an arched structure. The proposed work is to reinstate a doorway in the outbuilding to allow a door to be installed. The work will require the repositioning of an existing heating oil tank that is currently immediately adjacent to the proposed work.
