

Shed & front doors proposal, 3 West Green, Crail, KY10 3RD

Shed:

The dimensions of the shed are 4.7m long, 3m wide and 2.5m height.

The final height of the shed, with the base, is more likely to be around the 2.8m mark.

In my submission attachment photographs, the shed is shown with a felt roof. If the planning department allows, I would prefer to use slate tiles to finish the roof. I have calculated the extra weight of the tiles and have allowed for extra deep roof beams to compensate for this extra weight.

The wood used will be pressure treated soft wood timber of 18mm thickness, and will be stained in a natural wood colour, as per pre-application instructions.

Front door & Storm doors:

To replace the current, single glazed front door with a more energy efficient and secure double glazed door with additional storm doors as protection against the elements.

Bespoke doors, 50mm hardwood construction. Fitted with British Standard 5 lever locking system, with additional slip bolts for the storm doors. Double glazing to be 4/12/4lowE glass.

The doors will be constructed to fit into the present opening.

Paint finish to be dark grey (Farrow & Ball Downpipe or similar) to match the current façade.
