e.g. Oak (T3) - fell because of excessive shading and low amenity value. Replant with one standard ash in same position.

T1 - Horse Chestnut - Removal of deadwood in crown. 2-3m lateral reduction bringing limbs back in from road and through bay tree. Crown lift to 3 metres above ground level by removing small diameter branches < 75mm.

T2 - Hawthorn - Fell Tree. Tree is in poor health, cavities in stem, bark wounds. Tree to be replaced by one of the following: magnolia, ornamental cherry, olive or liquid amber

T3 - Sweet Chestnut. Crown reduction by 2-2.5m. Reduce radial branch spread by 2-2.5m with a maximum diameter of live pruning wounds <100mm. Crown clean and thin by removing deadwood

T4 - European Lime Crown reduction back to previous pruning points. Crown clean by removing deadwood. Remove epicormic growth at the base. Manage ivy.
