Materials (see plans attached)

Back exterior wall:

Window to the back wall of the property to be in line with exterior existing building (garage). Window will be placed in this position to encompass a sink area in the interior overlooking the garden. Facing K-render around the window pane.

Again , the back wall of the rear single storey extension will incorporate bifold doors due to recommended sealing and locking method. Facing K-render around the bifold.

Roof:

Roof will incorporate a glass strip roof light to the left of the extension accumulating 5.9m in length and 1m in width adjoining to the current existing property line. This will allow a high percentage of light distribution within the interior family /dining area and also to the exterior of the property , appearing lighter and more spacious to neighboring properties.

The roof will also include a large roof lantern to the right of the roof to allow for extra natural lighting above what will be a breakfast bar. Full cavity to existing exterior wall to prevent damp and water ingress.

New guttering will surround the exterior.

Side of the property (drive way)

As the driveway is too small to fit a vehicle we plan to place a pyc door attached to the utility room. Facing brick surrounding the pyc door. Two stone steps will be placed underneath the access to the doorway for safety.
