### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS

A planning application has been made to Portsmouth City Council as follows:

**PROPOSAL:** Construction of 20 dwellings (14 houses and 6 flats) with associated  
landscaping and parking, with vehicular access from Gold Street and  
Diamond Street (20/01493/FUL)

Should you wish to draw the Case Officer's attention to any particular view, or feature, or part of the local character, beyond what you may submit in writing, please send in photos, or perhaps a 'virtual' site visit/video. This will enable the Case Officer to better assess the proposals and any comments you may have.*

Comments must be made by **23 April 2021** in writing to the Civic Offices, or e-mailed to [planningreps@portsmouthcc.gov.uk](mailto:planningreps@portsmouthcc.gov.uk). The Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985 allows any representation to be seen by other members of the public including the applicant. *Because of the on-going restrictions to daily life and concerns about health due to the COVID 19 virus, we are giving a longer period of time than usual for any public comments (42 days instead of the statutory minimum of 21).*

Only a small number of applications are determined by the Planning Committee. If this application is to be determined by the Committee, you will not be notified unless you have commented and requested to speak at the Committee.
