It is recognised that the trees form part of the highway frontage, and in that context they attach a level of public amenity. However one tree has been affected by previous inappropriate pruning works and the two trees growing together could be subject to a complaint under the High Hedges Legislation is left in situ as a 'single form'. It is hoped that some canopy reduction works and clearances over the highway, undertaken in accordance with good management practices by a competent Arborist, will help to bring the trees into a reasonable shape and form, such that they can be regularly managed going forwards, ensuring that local screening, amenity and ecology is not significantly affected over the longer-term.

### RECOMMENDATION

Approve subject to the following condition(s) and reason(s):-

1. All works to be undertaken in accordance with British Standards BS 3998:2010 (Tree Works) by a suitably qualified and insured Arborist.

2. The consent is valid for 2 years from the date the decision is issued. If works are not completed within that timescale then a new application will need to be submitted to the Planning Authority.
