Justification for Variation of condition

This application seeks to move the boundary of approved House A slightly to the south. The extract at image 1 shows the approved layout and image 2 the variation with the amended location of the boundary highlighted. The garden for house A will change from 70sqm to 55sqm. Access to the rear garden will be retained. There are no other changes proposed to the approved scheme.

It should be noted that in the amended proposal the eaves of the House A are shown to overhang the boundary, whilst the boundary fence will run up to the building itself.

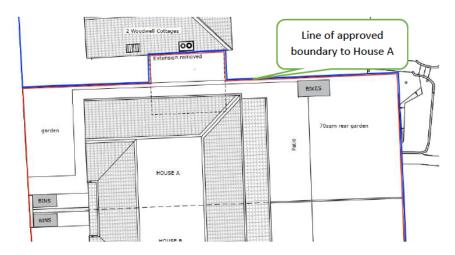


Image 1: Extract from approved Block Plan (approved drg ref: 19/1724/115 Rev J - received by BCC 9/7/20)

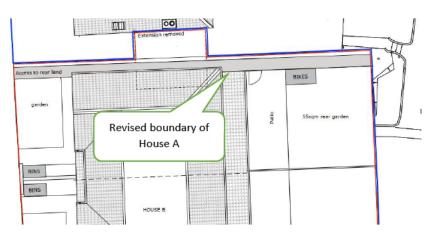


Image 2: Extract from amended proposed Block Plan (drg ref: 19/1724/115 Rev L - received by BCC 9/7/20)
