Willow tree - this needs to be removed as we have had subsidance in the past caused by a willow tree of a similar size and the same distance from the house. We plan to replace this tree with a smaller variety. Mixed hedge (approx.16 metres) including elder and sycamore and some stumps which are already dead. We are planning to replace the hedge with a new hawthorn hedge after having the ditch dug out to improve drainage.
