Town and Country Planning Act 1990, Section 211 - Notification of Intention to carry out work to trees within a Conservation Area at 11 Tudor Road Anerley London SE19 2UH

Thank you for your application received on 17th March 2021 in which you notified this Council of your intention to carry out the following works:

- **Ivy-covered Holly (approximately 10m in height) in rear garden - Fell.**
- **Hazel trees (approximately 5m in height) on both sides of garden - Cut back by 2.7m.**
- **Yew tree (approximately 6m in height) in rear garden - Cut back by 2.7m.**

at the above address which is situated in the Belvedere Road Conservation Area.

This Council now has six weeks to consider the intended works and determine whether it would be appropriate to make a Tree Preservation Order for the trees which are to be subject to the proposed works.

The six weeks will expire on 28th April 2021. The purpose of the six weeks is to allow time for this Council to fully consider all aspects of the work proposed. It also allows the opportunity for any interested persons to make representations to this Council in connection with the proposed works. The Council will take any comments received into account when determining whether to make a Tree Preservation Order.

The Council considers that it is desirable that adequate publicity is given to all applications to carry out work to trees within a Conservation Area. As such I would be grateful if you could display the enclosed notice in a position that can be seen by the passing public for the period up to and including the date shown. It would be helpful if you could confirm in writing that you have been able to do this.
