SOFTWORKS

- S1 - Existing Grass retained. Areas to be managed and maintained to create pockets of long grasses with mown strips adjacent to circulation routes
- S2 - Shrub and Herbaceous Mix within Eco-Pod 'Habitats' (PHM)
- S3 - Grassland; long grasses with singular shrub planting in wider expanses
- S4 - Hedging; formal hedging (beech) to car park areas and enclosing Pod 'Habitats'
- S5 - Hedging; Naturalistic using native species mix to boundary
- S6 - Market Garden plots; ordered lines of fruit/vegetable and salad crop.
