Statement For Alport Farm Caravan & Campsite

Overton Heath Lane Malpas SY14 7DG

For the application of planning permission for the addition for 11 static caravans and 8 additional touring caravan pitches and 1 wardens hut.

This application seeks to extend the existing caravan/campsite by around 0.77 hectares by utilising part of the adjacent lower westerly 5.97 hectare grassland field currently used for grazing and leaving the remaining 5.2 hectares as grazing, as is.

The proposed will add an additional 11 static caravans and 1 wardens hut, with service track and also increase the CW&C licensed touring caravan pitches from 22 to 30 and again adding a service track. This will be partly achieved by deleting 3 pitches for the existing campsite and adding them to the proposed. This application also seeks to add a warden's hut to the proposed static caravan pitches.

History

Alport farm campsite has been a licensed campsite for over 30 years. Under application 6/20601 & 00/01317/FUL the site is licenced for 22 caravans.

Under application 19/03783/FUL the site has granted approval for the erection of a toilet block, service road with low level lighting.

Amenities

Under 19/03783/FUL the toilet block is still within the required limits for the additional caravan pitches.

Landscaping

This application will not remove and hedgerows or trees and seeks to plant approximately 45+ new trees in various areas around the proposed site as shown on the plan.

Static caravans

There will be 2x two bedroom disabled with wheelchair access static caravans, 5x two bedrooms static caravans and 4x three bedrooms static caravans. Solar (PV) photovoltaic panels fitted on the roof will provide most of the power and heating when possible.


Lighting
