Reference to your email this morning there seems to be some confusion because I've used the same sketch plan from a previous application which was for the felling of the diseased ash tree and pruning of the dead wood on 2 oak trees.

Your reference for the work to the diseased ash tree was exempt under the TPO, your reference PP-09626221 re Miss Zoe Baker dated 18/03/2021. The second application reference PP-09671872v1 is to prune 30% reduction of the oak trees to the live branches above the driveway and buildings. Hope this clears up the confusion.
