



CONFORMITY WITH ICNIRP PUBLIC EXPOSURE GUIDELINES (“ICNIRP”)

BT Wholesale and Ventures propose when deploying mobile radios units within a structure BT will always:

1. Comply with ICNIRP guidelines and regulation
2. Provide an ICNIRP certificate for every site completed as standard practice
3. Contractually oblige customers not to exceed agreed ICNIRP power outputs

Therefore any proposed equipment and installation and any existing equipment installed in a BT Street Hub unit will be designed to be in full compliance with the requirements of the radio frequency (RF) public exposure guidelines of the International Commission on Non-Ionising Radiation Protection (ICNIRP), as expressed in EU Council recommendation of 12 July 1999* “on the limitation of exposure of the general public to electromagnetic fields (0 Hz to 300 GHz)” in all areas legitimately accessible to the public.
