

CONFORMITY WITH ICNIRP PUBLIC EXPOSURE GUIDELINES ("ICNIRP")

BT Wholesale and Ventures propose when deploying mobile radios units within a structure BT will always:

- 1. Comply with ICNIRP guidelines and regulation
- 2. Provide an ICNIRP certificate for every site completed as standard practice
- 3. Contractually oblige customers not to exceed agreed ICNIRP power outputs

Therefore any proposed equipment and installation and any existing equipment installed in a BT Street Hub unit will be designed to be in full compliance with the requirements of the radio frequency (RF) public exposure guidelines of the International Commission on Non-Ionising Radiation Protection (ICNIRP), as expressed in EU Council recommendation of 12 July 1999* "on the limitation of exposure of the general public to electromagnetic fields (0 Hz to 300 GHz)" in all areas legitimately accessible to the public.
