Medium large ornamental plum tree in private garden which has not come into leaf this spring. The tree was in visible decline for the last couple of years and can now be assumed standing dead.

If you can advise whether or not we have to wait for a planning permission (6 weeks) for the dismantle/felling of the tree as we are worried it will soon start to déteriorate and potentially drop limbs etc.

Client is prepared and happy to plant a replacement tree in their garden.
