With regard to the planned use of the Star Hill exit it would have a detrimental impact on not only Knockholt but the surrounding villages with the huge increase in traffic it would generate.

Star Hill road is badly maintained, has no footpath, is narrow, has blind bends, enjoyed by cycling clubs (the cyclists are impossible to overtake) and is the scene of many accidents.

Our village of Knockholt is already spoilt by speeding cars and heavy lorries with no notice taken of speed limits.

The Star Hill exit has always had restricted access (ie.early morning and late afternoon) with only cars using it. We object to the exit on Star Hill as the Poll Hill access can be made safer by installing a large roundabout with speed restrictions to slow the approaching traffic.

As residents of Knockholt we also object to this needless development of Fort Halstead on Green Belt land.
