We would like to let you know of our objection to the proposed New Planning Application to building a further 300 homes, in addition to the 450 already given planning permission in 2015.

RE: The **government** today (Monday 4 November 2019) launched a £50 million **scheme** to help boost **tree-planting** rates in the fight against climate change. The new Woodland Carbon Guarantee will encourage farmers and landowners to **plant** more **trees** and create new woodland in return for payments as those **trees grow**.

Surely this would be a far better option for our community and our environment - perhaps Broke Hill could be made into a Woodland Park for the local community too, with a cycle track, skate board facilities, lakes for bird and wildlife, cafe, etc. Hey wouldn't that be a novel idea instead of a mass of unnecessary concrete?
