I would like to add my voice to the growing concern over the changes in the proposed development at Fort Halstead.

I appreciate it is difficult to argue or stand in the way of development, however as we continue to cement and concrete over our green and pleasant land, we should at least stop and consider is it necessary or is it driven by other motives?

The green belt is precious and attempts to alter the landscape have to take into account many factors such as the surrounding infrastructure and the possible implications of allowing the green belt to be over run.
