Comment:I strongly oppose this application. This amendment does not make any substantial changes to the previous application so my previous objections still apply. This was always meant to be a commercial led development with the houses being secondary to the business park. The present one does not mention this. It increases the number of houses and cuts the commercial area from 3.6 hectares to 2.7. They are clearly trying to increase the number of more profitable houses at the expense of the commercial.

There is no infrastructure to deal with the extra traffic this will cause. The road at Polhill is slowly slipping down the side of the hill and has had to be reduced in width for this reason. There was a report commissioned about 10 years ago which stated the enormous cost at that time to make it safe but highways stated they had no plans to carry out the work. These extra houses would make the situation much worse.

The site is extremely contaminated after years of work with with explosives, including the development of the atomic bomb by Dr William Penney We have received no independent assurances that this can and has been removed and made safe.

The proposed density of the site with the increase from 450 to 635 is 38.35 dph. This is twice the existing density locally. There are also some areas which will be up to 55 dph. This is unacceptable on a rural green belt site..

I know there is pressure to build many houses but please do not increase this development to this size and desecrate an area of outstanding natural beauty.
