Comment: This seems an unsuitable area for so many properties. With little local public transport

or parking at Knockholt Station. It will severely disrupt commuters who already use it.

Local towns and villages will be swamped with more traffic, and as many roads have no footpaths cyclists and walkers face serious threats to their safety.

The two main shopping areas at Otford and Dunton Green are both approached by narrow and at times congested roads, this is hardly likely to improve matters.

This will put considerable stress in beautiful green belt areas, and almost certainly will put pressure on the authorities to provide better, safer and more roads and facilities to cope with a larger population.

Unless new roads are provided, school places and nurseries, shops, transport and parking for the increased population, then this site is completely unsuitable for this application.
